<b>Vagina</b>	- Urinary bladder (pelvis). - Urethra (perineum).	- Rectum (pelvis). - Anal canal (perineum).	Ureters (pelvis)	---
<b>Perineum</b>	Mons pubis	Intergluteal folds	Medial surfaces of the thighs	---
<b>Bony boundaries of Perineum</b>	Symphysis pubis.	Coccyx.	- Ischiopubic rami. - Ischial tuberosities. - Sacrotuberous ligaments.	---
<b>Urogenital triangle</b>	Symphysis pubis	Transverse line passing through the 2 ischial tuberosities.	- Ischiopubic rami. - Ischial tuberosities.	<b>Contents:</b> - Lower part of urethra & vagina. - External genitalia (vulva).
<b>Superficial perineal pouch</b>	---	---	Ischiopubic rami	- <b>Inf:</b> Membranous layer of superficial fascia. - <b>Sup:</b> Perineal membrane.
<b>Deep perineal pouch</b>	---	---	Inferior portion of obturator internus fascia	- <b>Inf:</b> inferior fascia of the urogenital diaphragm (perineal membrane). - <b>Sup:</b> superior fascia of the urogenital diaphragm.
<b>Anal triangle</b>	- Perineal body. - Urogenital diaphragm. - Lower part of vagina.	- Coccyx. - Anococcygeal body.	- Ischial tuberosity. - Sacrotuberous lig. - Ischiorectal fossae.	<b>Contents:</b> - Lower part of anal canal. - Ano-coccygeal body. - Ischiorectal fossa on each side.
<b>Ischiorectal fossa</b>			Obturator internus	- <b>Base:</b> skin of the perineum. - <b>Medial wall:</b> levator ani & anal canal.
<b>False pelvis</b>	Lower part of the anterior abdominal wall.	Lumbar vertebrae.	Iliac fossae and the iliacus muscle.	It supports the abdominal contents.
<b>Pelvic inlet</b>	Symphysis pubis.	Promontory of sacrum, ala of sacrum	Ileopectineal (arcuate) lines.	
<b>Pelvic outlet</b>	Symphysis pubis.	Coccyx.	---	- <b>Anterolaterally:</b> Ischiopubic ramus - <b>Posterolaterally:</b> Sacrotuberous ligament.
