## Definition of Community service

- Community is a group of interacting people, living in the same proximity (in space, time, or relationship).
- Community usually refers to a social unit larger than a household that shares common values and has social cohesion

In most cases, community service work is performed by volunteers who are not paid for their time.

- Community Service: is defined as donated service or activity that
  is performed by someone or a group of people for the benefit of the
  public or its institutions.
- Some people associate community service with punishment -for offenders as an alternative to jail time..
- However, community service can also be altruistic -unselfish-, and it is
  a vital part of many small communities.
- Basically anything which benefits the society in any way can be considered as a community service project or activity.

#### Mention some examples of community service?

- Visiting and spending time with lonely elderly.
- Tutoring needy students in their studies for free.
- Helping out at organizations such as libraries.

## Why to carry out community service?

- ★ Benefits the community

#### 10 Essential services of stakeholders:

- 1. Monitor health status to identify community health problems.
- 2. Diagnose and investigate health problems and health hazards in the community.
- 3. Inform, educate, and empower people about health issues.
- 4. Mobilize community partnerships to identify and solve health problems.
- 5. Develop policies and plans that support individual and community health efforts.
- 6. Enforce laws and regulations that protect health and ensure safety.
- 7. Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provision of health care when otherwise unavailable.
- 8. Assure a competent public and personal health care workforce.
- 9. Evaluate effectiveness, accessibility and quality of personal and population-based health services.
- 10. Research for new insights and innovative solutions to health problems.

Tele-monitoring, tele-tutoring. Work Environmental volunteering: eg. Protecting animals, education about natural environment. School volunteering: additional teaching for students. School volunteering: additional teaching for students. Emergency volunteering: during natural disasters. Community volunteering: for orphanages, widows, mosques, blood donation, during Hajj and Ramadan,..etc. International Work - Camps: environmental conservation, rural developments, etc.
