

Drugs used in headache & migraine

For extremely fast relief within 15 min—i njectable <u>sumatriptan</u> is the only choice.
If expected re-dosing is needed or recurrence of headache—Naratriptan, <u>frovatriptan</u>, have <u>slower onset,</u> fewer side effects, and lower recurrence rate

The form of drug preparation could influence the choice → Injectable sumatriptan reaches Tmax the fastest followed by DHE nasal spray

- Triptanes are selective 5-HT1 agonists thus they decrease:
- 1. Release of Vasodilating peptides.
- 2. Excessive firing of nerve ending.
- Domperidone is a dopamine antagonist.
