Some TB features:

Fever with night sweat, Loss of weight, Cough and sputum, Malaise, fatigue, anorexia.

Case: TB patient	
Question	Indications
1-When was diagnosed? Based on which type of investigations?	
2-Did he/she have been in the isolation? If yes, for how long?	
3-Previous steroid use.	
4-What is the treatment he/she receives?	
5-Was there any improvement?	
6-Any complications of either the illness or the treatment.	
Fever, weight loss, loss of appetite, night sweat	
Risk Factors	
Hx of contact with TB infected person or any other respiratory infection	
Past Medical History	
<i>Do you have previous history of surgery procedures or hospital admissions?</i>	
<i>Blood transfusion or allergies?</i>	

Drug History	
If he takes steroid	
Family History	
<i>Does anyone of your family members have similar problem?</i>	
Social History	
<i>Do you smoke?</i>	
Smoking, alcohol, occupation?	
Systemic Review	

What is the 1st line of treatment of TB? STRIPE

- Streptomycin
- Rifampicin
- Isoniazid
- Pyrazinamide
- Ethambutol
