Constipation:

Constipation is common symptom and it can refer to the infrequent passage of stools (fewer than three times per week), hard stools or stools that are difficult to evacuate

Differential diagnosis:

Chief complaint (constipation)		
Onset?	acute chronic : >3 month	
if acute ?	are you able to pass gas? if no gas at all: complete obstruction do you have abdominal pain, vomiting or nausea? intestinal obstruction previous surgery?adhesion → obstruction	
if chronic?	1)sensation of incomplete evacuation? IBS 2)abdominal pain and bloating associated with bowel movement ? IBS 3) how is your appetite, sleep, mood, concentration, interest in thing? Depression 4)have you had any weight gain, decrease energy level, swelling in your legs? hypothyroidism	
are your stools thin like a pencil	Narrowing of the distal colon, sigmoid, or rectum from colon cancer or stricture	
Do you pass mucus?	IBS	
Any blood in the stools?	Colon cancer, hemorrhoids, fissures, ulcers	
Do you stain excessively on passing stool?	Occur with : Disorder of the pelvic floor muscles or nerve Anorectal disease (fissure ,stricture)	
Do you feel there may be a blockage at the anus area when try to pass stool?	Defecatory disorder	
Are you able to pass gas?	Failure to pass gas suggests complete intestinal obstruction	
Do you ever press your finger in around the anus (or vagina) to help stool pass?	Defecatory disorder	
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Has your bowel habit changed recently?	could indicate malignancy
What were your bowel habits like before this episode?	 Prior abnormal bowel habits: chronic condition progressing to complete intestinal obstruction Bouts of constipation alternating with diarrhea: colon cancer, IBS, diabetic autonomic neuropathy, fecal impaction
Any abdominal pain? Is pain made better by a bowel movement?	IBS Intestinal obstruction
Any recent weight loss?	colon cancer
diarrhoea Alternating with constipation?	IBS
Do you have a history of colon polyps or cancer? Any family history of colon cancer?	Colon cancer

Management:

- 1- Diet and behavioral modification are the most important aspects of treatment. Advise the patient to:
- a. Increase physical activity
- b. Eat high-fiber foods
- c. Increase fluid intake
- 2. Use an enema, such as a disposable Fleet enema, for temporary relief if no bowel movement occurs despite the above measures or if the patient is bedridden.
- 3. If obstruction is present, urgent surgery consultation is indicated.

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
