

Management of Multiple Injured Patients

Objectives:

1. Diagnose, initially manage and to know when to immediately refer a patient with a condition that requires urgent specialist management.
2. Identifies the patient with multiple injuries and management as per ATLS protocol.
3. Demonstrate knowledge about the in-line immobilization of cervical spine while managing the airway.
4. Demonstrate the function of spinal board as a transfer tool only.
5. Demonstrate knowledge about emergency orthopedic conditions that affect the patient life and its initial management; e.g. open book pelvis fracture, bilateral femur fractures, mangled extremity.
6. Demonstrate interpersonal and intrapersonal communication skills that result in the effective exchange of information and collaboration with emergency medical service (ambulance and immediate responders) colleagues, nurses, patient, and health care professionals.
