S	Setting	<ul> <li>Ensure you are in a comfortable confidential room where you will not be interrupted.</li> </ul>			
Р	Perception	<ul> <li>Events that have led up to now.</li> <li>Ask them what they already know/expect.</li> <li>Spend some time trying to get them to say what the diagnosis is.</li> </ul>			
1	Invitation	<ul> <li>Check if the patient:</li> <li>Wants to know the result now.</li> <li>Would like a family member to be present.</li> </ul>			
К	Knowledge	<ul> <li>Giving the diagnosis:</li> <li>Build up to the result – give a warning shot.</li> <li>Chunk the diagnosis (stepped approach).</li> <li>After every statement you say, pause &amp; wait for the patient to ask the next question.</li> </ul>			
E	Emotions and Empathy	<ul> <li>Acknowledge and reflect their emotions back (including body language).</li> <li>Don't try to solve their problems or reassure them, just listen and summaries/ bounce their concerns back to them and expand on them (it shows you are listening and conveys empathy).</li> <li>If there is a lot of silence, you can ask about their emotions .</li> </ul>			
S	Strategy and Summary	<ul> <li>Agree on a plan.</li> <li>Summaries concerns.</li> <li>Ask how they are left feeling.</li> </ul>
