# The Process of the triage

Critical first look

Screening for infectious disease

Interviewing the patient

Objective assessment

Making the triage decision

CTAS

Level 1	Resuscitations
Level 2	Emergent
Level 3	Urgent
Level 4	Less urgent
Level 5	Non-urgent

- Level 1 – Continuous nursing care
- Level 2 – Every 15 minutes
- Level 3 – Every 30 minutes
- Level 4 – Every 60 minutes
- Level 5 – Every 120 minutes



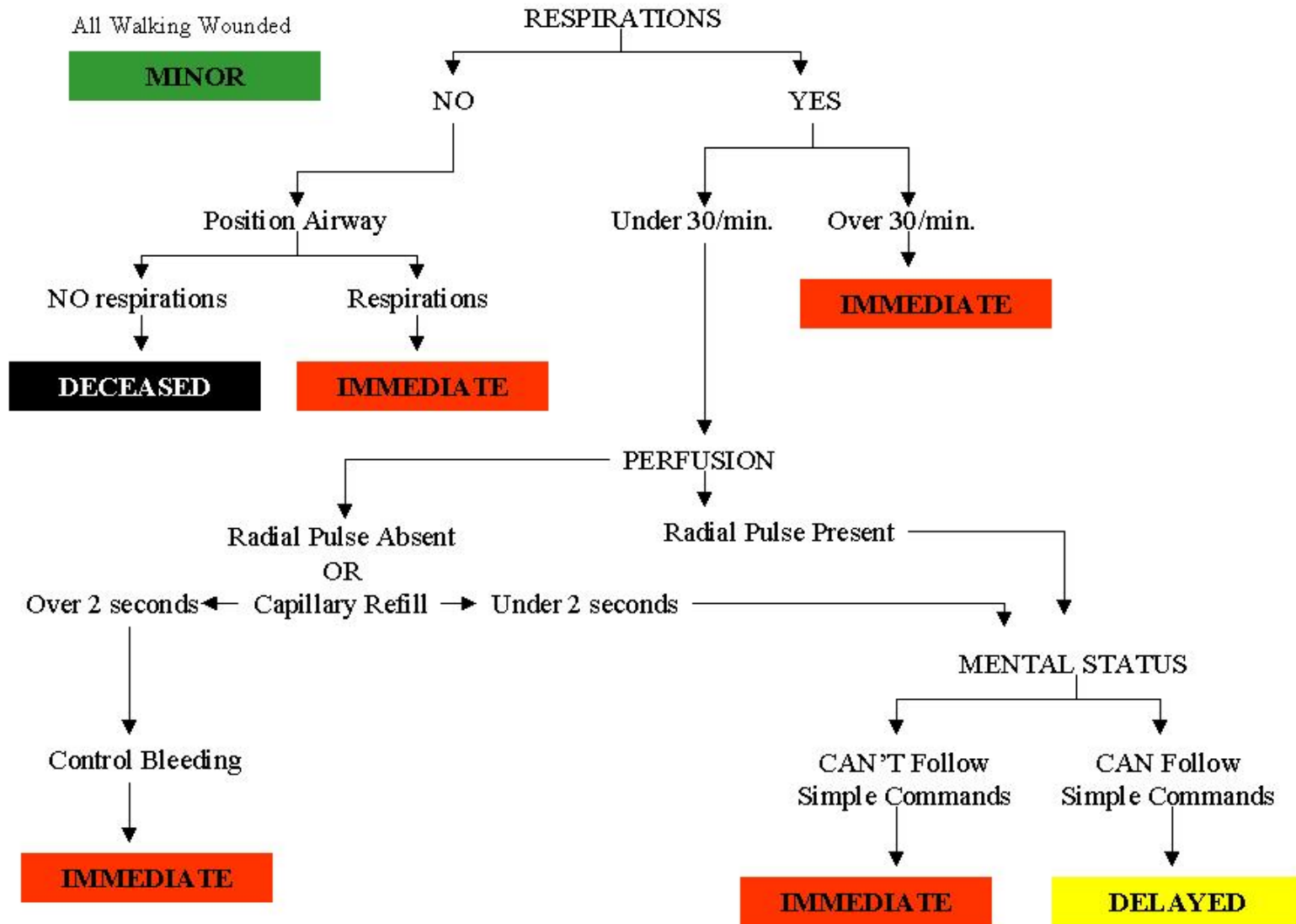
Let's summarize
