? What is MSRF?

Medical Students Research Forum (MSRF) serves as a meeting point for all health profession students in Saudi Arabia. It provides a platform for participants to showcase and exchange their latest research findings, discuss them, and compete for prizes awarded by the College of Medicine in King Saud University. It also features a set of workshops and lectures dedicated to a variety of topics of interest in the field of biomedical research.

? When and where will the conference take place?

The 7th Medical Students Research Forum will take place from the 10th to the 12th of April 2025 at King Saud University in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

? Will KSUMSC's 7th Annual Research Forum sessions be recorded?

? What are the phases of the forum?

There are two phases:

Phase 1 involves evaluating submitted abstracts from October 2024 until 5th of January 2025, with notifications sent via email to accepted abstracts.

Phase 2 involves the evaluation of oral/poster presentations, held on 10th-12th of April 2025, at King Saud University.

? Where do I find the details of the forum?

? Should I register to attend the forum?

Yes, you should register and fill out the form. A registration form will be posted on our social media platforms and website. In addition, there will be on-site registration on the forum days.

? Can I attend a workshop only and not the entire forum?

Yes, you can but you must register and fill out the form for attending the workshops.

? How do I register for a workshop?

A registration form will be posted on our social media platforms and website.
In addition, there will be on-site registration.

? Can my family members attend too?

The participants' families are very welcome to attend the forum but they have to register and fill out the form. The form will be sent throughout our social media platforms and website.

? How do I submit my abstract?

? Do I need to be a student at KSU to submit my abstract?

We accept all research by undergraduate students and interns from all universities, as long as it fits the condition stated here <https://ksumsc.com/MSRF>

? When will I be notified if my abstract has been accepted, rejected, or needs editing?

The coordinating presenter will be notified of their abstract status (accepted/incomplete/rejected) and presentation type (oral/poster) via email no later than 1 March 2025

? I haven't received a confirmation email after submission. What should I do?

The confirmation of acceptance or rejection will be on the website account of submission.

? Is it possible to change the presenting author or add another presenter after the abstract is accepted?

? How many abstracts can I submit?

There is no limit to the number of different abstracts you can submit. However, an author may present no more than two abstracts, one in each section (oral and poster). If MSRF accepts more than two submissions from an author, one of his/her co-authors must present any additional abstracts.

? How is the evaluation process done?

KSU faculty members will evaluate the abstracts anonymously to eliminate any potential bias. After having all abstracts evaluated by two evaluators, the top 24 are selected for oral presentations, and then 192 will be accepted for poster presentations (including 12 case reports).

? What do I need to bring to the forum?

You can bring your notebooks, laptops, Ipads or anything that helps you with taking notes during the lectures or workshops. Be ready to write notes, questions and discuss all about them.

? Will the event be filmed and photographed?

Yes, the highlights of the forum will be posted on our social media platforms, on X: @KSUMSC_RF.

? Do I need to be a student in KSU to attend?

No, the forum is open to all students.

? Can I attend for one day only?

Yes, you can attend only one day but you must register first on the forum.

? Will I be allowed to use my personal computer for my presentation?

For oral presentations, the podium is going to be equipped with everything you need to present your research, which we will upload in advance.

Yes, a total of 9 winners (3 for oral presentations, 5 for poster presentations and 1 for case reports) will be awarded a monetary prize in addition to a certificate of their place.

? Will I receive a certificate?

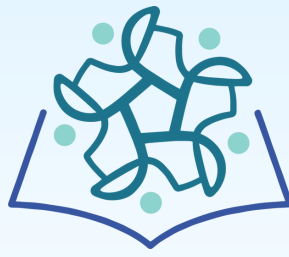
All research team members participating in oral presentations or poster presentation will receive a certificate bearing all their names. Attendees who have registered will receive a certificate of attendance.

No, your research does not need to be published in order to submit your abstract.
