#### Q What is MSRF?

The Medical Students Research Forum (MSRF) serves as a meeting point in the College of Medicine at King Saud University for all student medicine and health sciences research.

It provides a platform for participants to showcase and exchange their latest research findings. Participants discuss and compete for prizes awarded by the College of Medicine at King Saud University. The forum includes workshops and activities on various research-related topics.

#### ${f Q}\mid$ When and where will the forum take place?

The 7<sup>th</sup> Medical Students Research Forum (MSRF7) will be held from April 10<sup>th</sup> to April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at the College of Medicine, King Saud University, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

Can I change the presenting author or add a co-presenter during phase two evaluation after abstract acceptance?

No, once acceptance is confirmed, the submitted details are final and cannot be modified.

### Will MSRF7 sessions be recorded?

No, MSRF7 sessions will not be recorded. Participants are encouraged to attend in real time to engage in discussions, ask questions, and interact with experts.

### Q Can my family members attend too?

Yes! Participants' families are welcome to attend the forum. However, they will not receive a certificate of attendance or any other certification.

#### Q Will the event be covered on social media?

#### Q When will the winners be announced?

The winners will be announced during the closing ceremony on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

#### Q Will I receive a certificate?

Presenters will receive a single digital certificate acknowledging their presentation. The certificate will have the abstract title and the authors names as well. If an abstract wins in any category, a single physical certificate will be awarded, bearing the names of all authors.

#### Q Will there be awards?

Yes! A total of nine winners will receive awards: three winners for oral presentations, five winners for poster presentations, and one winner for case reports. Each winner will receive a monetary prize and a physical certificate.


#### Workshops

#### 03


#### **Oral Presentations**
